

MONMOUTH CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Meeting – October 8, 2013

The Monmouth Conservation Commission met for a first organizational meeting at the Town of Monmouth Municipal Office at 6:30pm on October 8, 2013. Present were Curtis Lunt, Town Manager, and commission members: Herb Whittier, Cindy Parker, Bob Mulliken, Doug Beck. Randy Schiller was unable to attend. The meeting began at 6:40pm.

Members Doug Beck, Bob Mulliken and Cindy Parker were sworn in by Curtis Lunt. Herb Whittier had already been sworn.

Initial terms of office were determined: 1-year term: Herb Whittier; 2-year term: Bob Milliken, Cindy Parker; 3-year term: Doug Beck, Randy Schiller (default). At the expiration of these terms, for a term of three (3) years thereafter.

Officers were determined: Chairman - Doug Beck; Vice Chairman - Herb Whittier; Secretary - Cindy Parker.

Copies of the Monmouth Conservation Commission ordinance and purpose were distributed.

There was an overview of projects for the commission including: Information gathering and disseminating, Whittier Woods Conservation Area notices or maps, Indexing of Open Areas owned by the town and Areas not owned by the town (with available use to the public), working relationships with like-minded organizations including Kennebec Land Trust and Maine Association of Conservation Commissions, and Evaluating Conservation Potential of properties currently town-owned.

The next meeting will be Tuesday November 12, 2013 at 6:30pm at the Town Office.
